Executive Director's Report

1997 has been a challenging year for Table Tennis New Zealand. It has been the first full year of the new Board and the new way of operating that that has brought, there has been an inevitable learning curve for myself as a new Executive Director, and we are in the process of radically changing our membership system, to name but three of the main factors.

In this report, I look at some of the main achievements of 1997 and look forward to 1998.

Individual Member Registration

One of the major projects of 1997 has been the development of Individual Member Registration (IMR). The impetus to change how TTNZ is funded has come from Associations unhappy with the previous system of affiliation fees worked out on a population basis. After widespread consultation, IMR was adopted and this system has developed and taken shape throughout the year, with numerous opportunities for Associations to have input into this process.

The two major advantages of IMR are that it provides TTNZ with an income based on the number of members that we have and that it also provides us with direct contact with these members. Next year will be a testing time as IMR is introduced, but we look forward to the support of all those in Table Tennis to ensure its success.

High Performance

This year saw New Zealand's best ever international result with Li Chunli's 3rd place at the Women's World Cup in Shanghai. Against an extremely strong field, including five players rated in the world's top ten, Chunli belied her then world ranking of 47 and was beaten only by the world's 2nd and 3rd ranked players on her way to 3rd place. As a result of her performance, her world ranking has risen to 28, the highest ever achieved by a New Zealander.

Earlier in the year, our Men's and Women's teams competed at the Commonwealth and World championships. The Men produced their best ever result with a fifth place in the teams event, and Peter Jackson and Shane Laugesen won a bronze medal in the Men's Doubles. Shane also won the fair-play award. The Women finished in 11th place. At the World Championships, the Men finished in 42nd place and the Women in 55th place.

New Zealand teams also competed at the Australian Open, the Asian Juniors, and Peter Jackson was Oceania's representative at the Men's World Cup in France.

In July, thanks to funding from Olympic Solidarity, we were privileged to be able to bring Swedish coach Tomas Stenberg to New Zealand. Tomas ran a week long course for our top players and coaches and it hoped that we will be able to bring him back to New Zealand on a regular basis. The course also included a workshop on our High Performance programme, and as a result of this we will be establishing a National Training Centre at North Harbour next year, to be run by new National coach Zhu Hui. This is an exciting new initiative, and in conjunction with the Table Tennis New Zealand Academy in Nelson, has the potential to ensure that our players are more prepared than ever for international competition.

Financial

TTNZ finished the year with an operating deficit of \$5,355. The main reason for this was one-off costs due to the restructuring of TTNZ which were unbudgeted for. A number of planned initiatives, principally national training camps, had to be cancelled due to lack of funds. The deficit would have been larger, but some \$17,000 extra funding and sponsorship was achieved. This consisted of \$10,000 from the Hillary Commission towards our restructuring, \$4,000 sponsorship from Pub Charity, and \$3,000 from the Sport Foundation that enabled us to send Zhu Hui and Richard Lee to a High Performance coaches course in Australia.

A worrying factor has been the number of Associations that have been unable to pay the set affiliation fees to TTNZ. These Associations, Waitemata, Auckland, Counties Manukau, Nelson and Otago

were not in a financial position to pay the fees set. Rather than insist on the full fees being paid, to the financial detriment of these Associations, TTNZ has negotiated with them for lesser amounts of fees to be paid. This has of course affected our income, but we have felt a compromise was a better option than placing these Associations in financial jeopardy.

A deficit budget has been presented for the 1997/98 financial year and additional funding needs to be raised quickly to ensure that we can achieve all we wish. In this money is not raised, a number of budgeted items will have to be cut.

Looking Ahead

Table Tennis stands at a crossroads. We have made a number of changes in the past 18 months, particularly in regard to how TTNZ is structured and operates. The job is only half done though. The real changes need to come at the grass-roots level, at the level where people join Table Tennis and play the game.

We are competing against other sports and other recreation and leisure options when it comes to attracting people to Table Tennis. I believe the key determining factor in the choices people make for their leisure time is not what it costs, but what value they perceive their choice gives them. We are fighting, in other words, over people's spare time.

For too long, it seems to me, Table Tennis has pitched itself as a cheap sport, believing that this is how we can attract people. History has shown this to be wrong. We are still a cheap sport to play, but our numbers have fallen drastically. We need to look critically at what we offer those playing the game and those thinking of playing the game. We need to be prepared to innovate - to change our product, our cost structures, our administration and management structures.

The workshop at this year's AGM is a chance to pose some of the hard questions necessary and to look for the answers. It is not going to be easy, and there are many hard choices still to make, but unless we start making them now, it will soon be too late.

Some Thank You's

It has been an enjoyable learning curve to me this year as a newcomer to Table Tennis. Those who have assisted me are too numerous to mention, but thank you for your patience. In particular, I would like to thank all administrators and coaches involved in Table Tennis throughout New Zealand, without your efforts we would have nothing. I would also like to single out the following people for their help, assistance and advice. David Jackson and Ron Menchi, who as the TTNZ Technical Committee have been the source of much Table Tennis knowledge. And John Kiley, TTNZ's Administration Officer, for his unfailing patience and good humour, and dedication to Table Tennis.

I look forward to working with all those involved in Table Tennis next year.

Membership

1997 saw a new system for ascertaining membership of TTNZ in the lead-up to the introduction of Individual Member Registration. Although our membership shows a decline from previous years, I suspect this is largely due to different ways of counting and that our figures this year present a more accurate picture of the affiliated members of Table Tennis New Zealand. They do not, however, include the large number of people playing in social clubs outside our system, and the much larger number of people playing social Table Tennis in New Zealand.

An extremely worrying fact is the small number of Women playing Table Tennis. Little over ¼ of our membership are Women. Investigating why, and rectifying this, will be a major focus for TTNZ in the next years.

General Accounting Policies

The measurement basis adopted is that of the modified historical cost system. Accrual accounting is used to match revenue and expenses.

Particular Accounting Policies

Accounts Receivable and Sundry Debtors are recorded at net realisable value, after eliminating doubtful debts.

Stock on Hand: Stock for resale has been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Depreciation for the following asset classes is provided on a straight line basis at rates that will write off the cost of the assets over their estimated useful lives which are as follows:

Office Equipment	5 years

Trophies are also now being written off over a five year period.

In respect to other asset classes, depreciation is being provided on a diminishing value basis at the following rates:

Goods and Services Tax: These financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis and any tax due or owing at balance date is shown in the Statement of Financial Position. GST is accounted for on the payments basis.
