Introduction

As Chairman of the Board of Table Tennis New Zealand, it's my pleasure to contribute a brief introduction to the 1999 Annual Report.

It's been an eventful year with major administrative changes, many hours spent on the road by the TTNZ and Oceania Development Officers, a wide range of international events, major advances made in communication particularly with regard to the web site, large membership increases in some areas, a new Kiwi Table Tennis Manual produced, a Hall of Fame launched, and a determined effort made to bring about what could have been the table tennis event of the decade – a tour of New Zealand by a star-studded national Chinese team.

Administration

Our Executive Director, Michael Brown, resigned on 1.9.99 and is being replaced by a team of volunteers assigned to specialist areas. The new system has potential to work well and it will free up a considerable amount of money to spend more directly on players and coaches.

National Development Officers

John Stapleton (Table Tennis New Zealand NDO) and Glenn Tepper (Oceania NDO) both toured New Zealand on separate occasions in 1999 (John early in the year, Glenn mid-year), and both were able to provide useful feedback on the state of table tennis in the various areas they visited. Both were received with enthusiasm and Glenn's school demonstrations were especially acclaimed.

International Events

These are covered elsewhere in the report and include the World Individual Championships, the Oceania Olympic and World Cup Qualifying Tournaments, a NZ/Australia Veterans Test Match, and the participation of New Zealand teams in the Australian Junior, Under 18 and Veteran Championships. The World Teams Championships were postponed till February, 2000.

Successes

- Li Chunli, Karen Li and Peter Jackson qualified, subject to National Selection Panel approval, for the 2000 Olympic Games
- Peter Jackson won the Oceania World Cup Qualifying Tournament
- Our boys and girls teams won the Australian Under 18 Team Championships

Other highlights

- The TTNZ web site "came of age", with a wide variety of extra services offered including tournament draws and up to the minute results. Robin Radford has done an excellent job with this and he also maintained the high standard of *Table Tennis Info* magazine.
- Very successful membership campaigns were waged by several Associations resulting in spectacular growth. Nelson and North Harbour must be mentioned, and there were a number of other areas where good progress was made.
- A new and very popular Kiwi Table Tennis manual was produced by a team of volunteers led by John Stapleton.
- Six NZ star players from 1970 or earlier were honoured as the inaugural inductees to the Table Tennis Hall of Fame
- A determined effort was made by Mike Brown to bring about a tour of New Zealand by a national team from China – an event which would have given table tennis a major boost had it come off.

I'd like to thank my fellow Board members for their assistance, and many thanks also to the players, coaches and administrators throughout New Zealand who keep the sport alive in their areas.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES for the year ending 30 September 1999

General Accounting Policies

The measurement basis adopted is that of the modified historical cost system. Accrual accounting is used to match revenue and expenses.

Particular Accounting Policies

Accounts Receivable and Sundry Debtors are recorded at net realisable value, after eliminating doubtful debts.

Stock on Hand: Stock for resale has been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Depreciation for the following asset classes is provided on a straight line basis at rates that will write off the cost of the assets over their estimated useful lives which are as follows:

Office Equipment	5 years
Computer Equipment	5 years

Depreciation is being provided on a diminishing value basis in respect to Office Furniture at 10% pa.

Goods and Services Tax: These financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis and any tax due or owing at balance date is shown in the Statement of Financial Position. GST is accounted for on the payments basis.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies since 30 September 1998

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

- (1) Accounts Receivable as at 30/09/99 totalled \$22,863. Approx \$21,000 of this amount is due from District Associations. Sundry Debtors (\$1760) is the total expected to be charged to the members of the NZ team at the Australian Junior Championships when costs are finalised.
- (2) \$17,500 of the 1999/00 Hillary Commission Grant was received prior to year end, and a grant of \$10,000 from the New Zealand Sports Foundation tagged for the World Teams Championships is held over due to the postponement of the event.
- (3) Funds held are in respect to monies originally received from the ITTF for the now cancelled Ball Research Project, and may need to be repaid.
- (4) Income from sponsorship is represented by a \$1,250 payment from John Vaughan & Co Ltd in return for the adoption of the Nittaku ball as TTNZ's adopted ball.
