Introduction

As we come to the end of our first full year without an Executive Director, we can say that the sport of table tennis has suffered no ill-effects as a result of that ground-breaking decision. There has been a cost, nonetheless. Full credit must go to John Kiley for managing and maintaining the busy National Office single-handedly, with some voluntary support. Some Board members are now carrying a burden of responsibility well beyond their normal Board duties and this situation is less than satisfactory. Ideally, Technical matters, High Performance, Coaching, Marketing, etc, should be in the hands of people outside the Board but locating suitable volunteers proved an immensely difficult task.

We would like to be able to appoint specialist volunteers to drive some of our key activities at national level in 2001.

Thanks to the dedication to the sport by our players and tireless work by a large number of people all over the country, 2000 has been a year of many highlights:

- Solid membership growth in many areas resulting in a 24% nationwide increase between 31.12.99 and 30.9.00
- Table Tennis "Coaches Count" resource kit funded and distributed nationwide by the Hillary Commission. (Thanks also to James Morris for his work on this)
- Fifty-one new Level One coaches accredited, and Level 2 Manual under way
- An Umpires Committee formed
- Three table tennis players at the Olympic Games, one reaching the last 32.
- Medals won at the Commonwealth, Oceania and Australian Championships
- An increase in our Hillary Commission and Sports Foundation funding for 2001
- Big increases in tournament participation at national and district level
- Increased table tennis activities in schools in many areas
- A visit by two overseas exhibition players
- Magazine and web page maintained at a high standard

On the negative side there are a very small number of associations suffering a downturn of fortune; the recurring problem of too few administrators (some areas are being managed by no more than one or two people); and a disproportionately low percentage of female members nationwide.

My wish for 2001 is for the dedication of players, coaches, umpires and administrators to continue at the same level; for more clubs to affiliate to their local association; for more volunteers to share the increasing workload at national and district level; and for everyone to keep enjoying their table tennis.

Awards

Player of the Year

Li Chunli was named 2000 Player of the Year. This was in recognition of her performance at the Sydney Olympic Games where she reached the last 32; at the Oceania Championships in New Caledonia where she won three gold medals; and at the Commonwealth Championships in Singapore where she won two bronze medals.

Junior of the Year – H N Ballinger Cup

The criteria used in awarding this cup cover sportsmanship, potential, dress, personality, enthusiasm, interest in club and/or Association management and playing results.

The winner for 2000 was **Kelly Samson (Canterbury)**

Junior Player of the Year – Russell Dickey Memorial Trophy

This trophy is awarded to the Junior player who has brought the most credit to New Zealand Table Tennis, taking into account performance, behaviour, neatness of presentation, co-operation and team spirit. The award can only be won once by any player.

The winner for 2000 was **Sandy Wang (Auckland)**

Coaching / Coach Education

Highlights for the year:

- The production and distribution in February of the table tennis version of the "Coaches Count" booklet and resource kit
- The KiwiSport accreditation early in the season of a large number of teachers and further KiwiSport accreditations and Level One assessments in Nelson, Wairarapa, Hawkes Bay and North Harbour
- The visit in September by Glenn Tepper (Oceania Development Officer) during which 21 more Level One Coaches were assessed and accredited.

Other significant events included:

- Two training camps – one pre-Oceania in North Harbour (disappointing attendance from Oceania team members but open to other trainees); and a national junior development camp in Nelson in July for which 31 juniors were selected.
- Development of Level Two manual and Level One assessment procedures.
- Attendance at two Hillary Commission elite player coaching workshops (Palmerston North and Wellington)
- Meeting with Sports Foundation to discuss carding of table tennis players for new High Performance Centre facilities
- Large increase in High Performance funding for 2000/2001 from Sports Foundation.
- Trips by New Zealand players and coaches to Commonwealth Championships, World Teams Championships, Oceania Championships, Australian Championships and Olympic Games.
- A start was made to set up regional coaching in some areas.

The work of all coaches at national, district, club and one-to-one level is acknowledged and appreciated.

James Morris, Director Coaching, Coach Education and High Performance

Technical

The Technical Committee's work was ongoing and responsive in areas such as the application of rules for the conduct of tournaments and other specialist regulations. Other issues dealt with included the introduction of the 40mm ball in 2001; the setting up of clear criteria for Association player representation; the allocation of 2002 national tournaments; ranking and seeding lists; work on the Umpires Committee's responsibilities; representing New Zealand at the Oceania General Meeting; liaising with the Tournament Review Committee; and approving tournament entry forms. The Committee communicated extensively with other Board members, other volunteers and the National Office.

Publicity

The treatment of table tennis by many newspapers in New Zealand is at the worst scatological, at the least obscene, and the recent North Island championships at Taupo and New Zealand championships at Christchurch have shown TTNZ what an enormous task it is to get major media outlets to acknowledge our views and news.

At present the national Publicity Director is concentrating on the print media first, radio second and television third.

Cinderella sports such as ours (I don't like minor) all have problems and it was interesting to see that Badminton New Zealand has appointed a Publicity Officer with Special Responsibility for NZ Herald. This seems quite extraordinary to admit that an especially appointed person deals with one newspaper and it begs an answer to a question about badminton's media problems south of the Bombays.

Newspapers will not lift a finger to us unless the news is sensational. Li Chunli's climb through the world rankings, her fall before the Olympics and her latest climb again, to our ping pongers was sensational, but the national media were not interested.

In a cynical way perhaps table tennis should report on some of our most famous off-table activities rather than the game. In recent times the biggest NZ Herald story on table tennis was when New Zealand's top umpire was sacked in the middle of a national final. It is noted that the final match result was a minor part of the story.

At Taupo and at Christchurch experienced journalists involved themselves at their own expense to report on the events and supply to NZ Press Association detailed results. North of the Bombays there were 5cm of details from each of the championships printed in the NZ Herald.

TTNZ Publicity Officers can but keep sending in their copy to local, city, national media outlets, and keep visiting these outlets.

Next year it is intended to produce a publicity pamphlet to help strengthen this part of table tennis administration. It is also hoped that publicity arrangements will be set up at each national-type tournament venue and treated as just as essential to the tournament as a table, bat, ball or umpire.

Dennis Galvin, Director Publicity

Umpires

An Umpires Committee of Robert Dunn (Chair), Michael McAvinue (Secretary), Val Scarr and Jim Jamin has been set up. This committee is now responsible for the distribution of Umpires Test Papers, and for assessing candidates. It has also been active in establishing a database of active umpires and has generated considerable interest from new umpires and from qualified umpires who had lapsed into inactivity. A large number of rule books have been distributed, coloured cards manufactured, and log books will be distributed early next year. The committee aims to educate all umpires to operate consistently and at the same high standard.

Three New Zealand umpires passed the International Umpires examination at the beginning of this year: David Jackson, Averil Roberts and John Stapleton.

Four new provincial umpires qualified for their badges and several others are in the process of obtaining their qualification.

Rankings

To qualify for a New Zealand ranking, players must have competed in a minimum of four rating events in any particular category, excluding B and C grades. Allowance is made for players who were unable to compete in rating tournaments due to overseas commitments.

The rankings are compiled by the Technical Committee. Age-group rankings were based on only results recorded in that age-group. Results from Under 18, 17 and 16 events were considered as well as Under 19 for the Under 19 list; and results from Under 15 and all younger age-groups were considered for the Under 15 list.

Funding for 2000/2001

We have been notified that funding from our two main supporting agencies will increase for the year 1.7.00 – 30.6.01. The Hillary Commission grant will increase by \$2000 to \$37,000, and the Sports Foundation grant will be \$29,000 (\$10,500 for the Commonwealth Championships; \$16,000 for the Australian Junior Championships; and a personal grant of \$2,500 for Li Chunli). Last year we received \$6,600 for Li Chunli and \$12,000 for Olympic preparation.

Adopted Ball

The Butterfly 3 star ball is the official ball from 1.1.00 to 31.12.01. The ball size changes to 40 mm on 1 May, 2001.

Communication

Issues 13, 14 and 15 of **Table Tennis Info** magazine were produced between 1.10.99 and 30.9.00 and mailed directly to each of our registered members. Both the size of the magazine and the range of contributors increased over the year. Editor Robin Radford continues to maintain a consistent standard of production - making the publication attractive to the eye by embellishing the text with photographs, artwork and cartoons. Staff member John Kiley provides support by sub-editing the text and contributing written material. A team of about ten volunteers regularly assists with the dispatch of nearly 4000 copies of the magazine in individual envelopes.

Robin Radford is also in sole charge of the TTNZ web site (www.tabletennis.org.nz), which has now become a real showpiece and attracts generous comment from within table tennis and beyond.

Communication with Associations was maintained by monthly Updates, reports on board meetings and sundry memos.

The measurement basis adopted is that of the modified historical cost system. Accrual accounting is used to match revenue and expenses.

Particular Accounting Policies

Accounts Receivable and Sundry Debtors are recorded at net realisable value, after eliminating doubtful debts.

Stock on Hand: Stock for resale has been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Depreciation for the following asset classes is provided on a straight line basis at rates that will write off the cost of the assets over their estimated useful lives which are as follows:

Goods and Services Tax: These financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis and any tax due or owing at balance date is shown in the Statement of Financial Position. GST is accounted for on the payments basis.

There have been no changes in accounting policies since 30 September 1999
