Introduction

I'd like to think that 2001 has been a year of improved communication – a year when players and officials have felt freer to articulate their concerns. I personally have met with Association officials and players on more than one occasion throughout the year and each time the experience demonstrated that an hour talking face to face can achieve more than months of written correspondence. Other examples include Murray Finch's groundbreaking magazine article probing the reasons why young players drop out of table tennis while still showing great promise. Our young players were willing to talk to him, and everything was passed on to Board level and noted. Then later in the year came Tracey McLauchlan's appointment as a Player Liaison Officer – a contact point for players to voice their concerns. Tracey's services have been well utilised, particularly at the New Zealand Championships.

Regarding communication in a more general sense, we have had yet another year when Table Tennis Info magazine maintained its high standard, and our web site went from strength to strength both in terms of quality and visitor numbers.

Our Publicity Director, Dennis Galvin, has worked hard this year to set up a network of Association publicity officers and he plans to issue a publicity manual. This is an area where people doing similar work in different parts of the country can benefit greatly by communicating with each other.

Related to this is the widening and decentralisation of some of our other key operational areas, notably coaching. David Cook was appointed Junior Development Officer, and Regional Coaches and Administrators were appointed and quickly went to work in Southland, Otago, Hutt Valley, Manawatu and North Harbour – running training camps for juniors in the wider surrounding areas. This structure relies on full and open communication among all those driving it.

The election of a new Umpires Committee augers well for continued communication within that specialist area as well.

2001 has been another good year. Chunli's silver medal at the Commonwealth Championships was not only a moment to cherish in itself, but also creates the real and exciting possibility of a Table Tennis medal at the Commonwealth Games next year. What a boost that would be to the sport. Our domestic tournament participation was healthy and increased in several areas, notably Counties Manukau which now has the use of Manurewa Club's impressive new stadium extension. Nationwide our membership continues its steady climb.

The Annual Report cannot be complete without my personal thanks to Administration Officer John Kiley for all his hard work and total dedication to table tennis. He is the "quiet achiever", always working in the background to ensure that the best is achieved for table tennis. John leaves on 21 November and I know that everyone involved in the sport wishes him well in the future.

I wish all table tennis players, coaches and officials the very best for 2002. And please, *keep communicating*.

Awards

Player of the Year

Li Chunli was named 2001 Player of the Year. This was in recognition of her excellent performance at the Commonwealth Championships in India where she won the silver medal in the women's singles.

Junior of the Year – H N Ballinger Cup

No nominations were received for this award in 2001.

Junior Player of the Year – Russell Dickey Memorial Trophy

This trophy is awarded to the Junior player who has brought the most credit to New Zealand Table Tennis, taking into account performance, behaviour, neatness of presentation, co-operation and team spirit. The award can only be won once by any player.

The winner for 2001 was **Jack Wells (Nelson)**

Funding for 2001/2002

We have been notified of the funding to be granted by our two main supporting agencies for the year 1.7.01 – 30.6.02. The Hillary Commission grant will increase by \$3000 to \$40,000, and the Sports Foundation grant will total \$43,000 (\$40,000 for international competition and Commonwealth Games preparation, and a \$3,000 personal grant for Li Chunli). Last year we received \$29,000, with \$16,000 carried forward to be included in this year's total.

We record our grateful thanks to these funding agencies for their continued support of Table Tennis.

Coaching / Coach Education

Highlights for the year:

- Setting up of four regional coaches and administration officers countrywide.
- Accrediting 24 Level One coaches, with seminars in two provinces.
- In conjunction with TTNZ, the Hillary Commission focused on Table Tennis in the KiwiSport magazine. This was then placed on their website to be accessed by teachers, coaches and interested persons.
- Extra financial support from NZ Olympic Committee for NZ selected players for preparation for the Commonwealth Games, 2002.
- Significant increase in funding from the Sports Foundation for elite players towards Commonwealth Games preparation.
- Funding support from NZ Olympic Committee for Olympic Solidarity Level Two Coaching Course with an overseas coach in 2002.
- The creation of the position of Junior Development Officer and the appointment of David Cook to the position.
- KiwiSport accreditation continuing for teachers.

Other significant events included:

- Two national training camps:
 - Pre-World and Commonwealth Championships held in Whangarei through significant sponsorship of \$18,356 enabling selected players to attend at no cost.
 - Junior Development Camp held in Nelson in April.
- Five Regional Camps held in Auckland, Palmerston North, Hutt Valley, Dunedin and Invercargill – all co-ordinated by Regional Coaches and Administrators.
- International Tours:
 - NZ players and coaches participated in Commonwealth Championships in New Delhi, India, and the World Championships in Osaka, Japan. The NZ Sports Foundation funded the use of a video analysis programme in conjunction with Auckland University of Technology for our carded athlete.
 - NZ Junior Players and Coaches participated in International Junior Championship in China.
- Meeting with Sports Foundation for proposed carding of NZ players who are to attend the 2002 Commonwealth Games.

I would like to sincerely thank all coaches who assisted with the continued development of table tennis in NZ throughout the year. Coaching at national, regional, club and one-to-one level is acknowledged and appreciated.

MARKETING

Over the past year we have had three deals at a stage where major companies were ready to commit a reasonable sum of money to TTNZ, but in the end, we were simply not attractive enough as a National Body for their final approval. As a result, a huge amount of time was wasted, but in doing so I learnt how professional we must be and that is something that we are not.

As a National Body we rely heavily on the local Associations to keep us running and in the three areas concerned, where the sponsorship was coming from, local Associations seemed to be doing very well by themselves and few had good words about TTNZ. This unfortunately filtered back on two occasions which definitely caused a change of mind and as a result the money was lost. This was very disappointing for me personally as I feel that table tennis has a lot to offer. There are so many people playing at the moment, over a very wide age group, which is why one of the companies (insurance) saw as quite a good catch. This was the major loss.

I see the main gripe that associations have with TTNZ is the amount of dollars paid to keep it going each year. If we are ever going to reduce this amount surely we must support our national body and help them raise the outside money that is desperately needed to fund all aspects of the sport. I hope that all the local Table Tennis Associations will rectify these problems and support the new Board who may be able to make a little more progress than was achieved this year.

So, congratulations to Auckland who made the most of a young Chinese team's visit and an outstanding final session to the recent New Zealand Open to gain some excellent television coverage. I understand, also, that a private film will be edited for commercial use. That's great.

The newspapers also carried all the results of the teams events and all the finals as well as stories.

If the media south of the Bombays did not see anything in their papers it was not the fault of Auckland.

During the year there were a number of names thrown up as publicity officers for their associations, but there still is a mysterious belief that a publicity officer is on the lower end of the pecking order. I know of at least one association PO who resigned after getting little or no support from the local association. We just cannot afford to lose these people.

In the next few months many associations will be holding annual general meetings so I implore these meetings to look on the Publicity Officer as an integral part of the elections or appointments.

It is hoped that a Publicity Manual will be finished early next year after the budgets have been announced and we are also hoping to set up a seminar fund in which publicity will be a key subject.

Rankings

International Events**Commonwealth Games, Manchester, 2002**

Preparations were begun this year to send a team to the first ever Commonwealth Games at which Table Tennis is a featured sport. Team and individual events are to be played.

A selection criteria was drafted by TTNZ and approved by the New Zealand Olympic Committee; a Sport Manager for Table Tennis was appointed; a training squad was selected and a build-up programme planned. The Table Tennis team is to be announced by the New Zealand Olympic Committee at the end of March, 2002.

International Programme, 2001

New Zealand players participated in the Commonwealth Championships in India, World Championships in Japan, and the Taiyuan International Junior Table Tennis Open Championships in China. A large amount of work went into preparation for these events by the selected players, by the High Performance Director (James Morris), by the selectors and by the officials accompanying each team.

Li Chunli's playing performance was especially impressive, winning the women's singles silver medal at the Commonwealth Championships.

A pre-event training camp was held in Whangarei prior to the Commonwealth and World Championships.

Appeal Tribunal

The services of Geoff Rau, Alan Boaden and Malcolm Darroch were sought and utilised on an Tribunal set up to hear an appeal lodged by North Harbour TTA over the decision to allocate the 2002 North Island Championships to Taupo TTA. North Harbour was a competing applicant for the event. The Tribunal dismissed the appeal. It's report included a number of procedural recommendations which were implemented by the TTNZ Board.

Table Tennis Academies

We acknowledge and commend the work done by the Table Tennis Academies at Lincoln University (operating with the support of Table Tennis Canterbury); and in Stoke, Nelson (operating with the support of Table Tennis Nelson).

Player Liaison

During the year the TTNZ Board appointed Tracey McLauchlan as a Player Liaison Officer, to give players a channel through whom to register any complaints, concerns, or suggestions.

40 mm Ball

From 1 May, 2001, the new international law requiring the 40 mm diameter ball to be used for all open championship play was applied in New Zealand. The ball size was previously 38 mm. The use of the larger ball was optional prior to 1 May and it was used at the Summer Nationals and NZ Veterans Championships.

The 38 mm ball may be used for domestic competition until 31.12.01 by which time supplies are expected to have run out.

Obituary

We record with regret the death on 27 May, 2001 of **John Lelliott**, former TTNZ Management Committee member, National Councillor, Selector, veteran player and Hutt Valley administrator.

Handbook

A major review of the TTNZ Handbook was carried out by various Board members in 2001 - updating the existing material and adding new sections on Individual Member Registration, Athletes Agreements and Disciplinary Procedures.

Adopted Ball

The Butterfly 3 star ball is the official ball from 1.1.00 to 31.12.01.

Communication

Table Tennis Info magazine

This magazine was launched in 1996 and issue No 1 was published in October that year. Issues 16, 17 and 18 were produced in the year ending 30.9.01 with all three issues mailed directly to each of our registered members. Editor Robin Radford is responsible for the high standard of production and has built up a vast library of photographs, clip-art, and cartoons as well as a network of professional artists and support personnel. Staff member John Kiley continues to provide support by sub-editing the text and contributing written material. A team of about ten volunteers assists with the dispatch up to 4000 copies of the magazine in individual envelopes.

TTNZ web site

Our web site (www.tabletennis.org.nz), continues to attract increasing numbers of visitors, favourable comments and useful suggestions. Originally set up by Mike Brown in 1998, it's development and day to day maintenance has since been in the hands of Robin Radford.
