CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR NORTH ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- All matches will be played under the Rules of the New Zealand Table Tennis Association.
- 2. Ball: Halex Three Star Ball will be used for all matches.
- Dress: Players must wear dark clothing in all matches; tennis shoes must be worn. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform with these requirements.
- 4. The Executive Committee reserves the right to seed the draw.
- 5. All Open Championship events shall be the best of five advantage games of 21 points up; all Junior and other events shall be the best of three advantage games of 21 points up.
- 6. Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match be concluded, provided that, when necessitated by circumstances not within the control of the players, the Umpire may suspend play for such period as he may consider necessary. Play shall never be suspended for the purpose of allowing a player to recover his strength or his wind. The Umpire shall be the sole judge of intentional delay, and after giving warning, he may disqualify the offender.
- The Referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final.
 The decision of the Umpire on a point of fact is final.
- 8. The tournament is under the control of the Tournament Manager, Mr. M. M. Gordon.
- 9. The Referee is Mr. R. W. Owen.
- 10. Matches commence at 9.30 am. each day unless advised by the Tournament Manager at the Hall. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who arrives late.
- Competitors must report to the official in charge on arrival each day.
- 12. Entries. ACCOMPANIED BY FEES, must reach the Treasurer, Miss M. Broadbent, P.O. Box 245, by 5 p.m. on THURSDAY, 26th JUNE, 1952. Late entries will not be accepted. Entrants for Junior events must have their age certificate properly attested.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR WANGANUI OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

The conditions of play for the Wanganui Open shall be the same as for the North Island Championships except Rule 5, which will read:—"Men's Open Singles and Ladies' Open Singles' Events will be the best of five advantage sets of 21 points up; all other events

will be the best of three advantage sets of 21 points up."

Explanation:—This latter Rule is imposed only because of the time factor and heavy entries usually received.


