

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. All matches will be played under the rules of the New Zealand Table Tennis Association Inc.
- 2. Ball: The Dunlop Barna 3-Crown ball will be used for all matches.
- 3. Dress: Players shall not wear white or light-coloured clothing which might tend to unsight an opponent. Rubber soled tennis shoes must be worn. The racket must be as laid down by the N.Z. Association. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform to these requirements.
- 4. Draw: The draw will be seeded.
- 5. All Open Championship events shall be the best of five advantage games of 21 points up; all junior and other events shall be the best of three advantage games of 21 points up.
- 6. The "expedite rule" will be enforced.
- 7. Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match be completed, provided that when necessitated by circumstances not within the control of the players, the Umpire shall suspend play for such period as he may consider necessary. Play shall never be suspended for the purpose of allowing a player to recover his or her strength or wind. The Umpire shall be the sole judge of intentional delay, and after giving warning, he may disqualify the offender.
- 8. The Referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final. The decision of the Umpire on a point of fact is final.
- 9. The Tournament is under the control of the Tournament Manager, Mrs M. MacGibbon, and Mr G. Graham is the Deputy Tournament Manager.
- 10. The Referee is Mr A. Thomas.
- 11. Competitors must report to the official in charge on arrival.
- 12. Juniors under 16 years of age will be permitted to play in both age groups as well as the open events. Competitors are warned that in the event of any dispute regarding the eligibility of competing in the age group events it may be necessary to demand verification of the date of birth.
- 13. Entrants in the Junior events must have their age certificates properly attested by the completion of the certificate on the entry form.
- 14. Entries, accompanied by the entry fees, must reach the Secretary, P.O. Box 858, Palmerston North, by Friday 3rd September. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 15. Hours of play: The tournament will commence at 9.00 a.m. with the junior events. The senior events will not commence before 10.00 a.m. Play will be continuous from commencement until the tea adjournment at approximately 5.30 p.m., resuming not later than 7.00 p.m. (Light meals will be available at the hall throughout the day.)
 - NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO LUNCHEON BREAK.
- 16. Consolation singles events will be conducted for those who lose their first match in the Championship Singles (Post entry 2/6).
- 17. A social will follow the finals.
