CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. All matches will be played under the Rules of the N.Z. Table Tennis Association (Inc.)
- 2, Ball: The Dunlop Barna 3 Crown ball will be used for all matches.
- 3. <u>Dress</u>: Players must wear grey or dark clothing in all matches; tennis shoes must be worn. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform to this rule regarding dress.
- 4. The Association's Tournament Seeding Committee will make and seed the draw.
- 5. The Referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final.

 The decision of the umpire on a point of fact is final.
- 6. Competitors must report to the officials in charge on arrival at each session and must also report when leaving the Hall or Gymnasium at any time.
- 7. Amount of back play will be Hall 15ft, Gym 13ft. Amount of side play will be Hall $11\frac{1}{2}$ ft, Gym. 10 ft. Lighting at least to the minimum requirements as approved by the N.Z.T.T.A. will be used.
- 8. Matches will commence at the times stated on front page. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who arrives late unless prior arrangements have been made with the Tournament Manager.
- 9. Events 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall be the best of five games of 21 points up; all other events shall be the best of three games of 21 points up. Entrants for Junior Events must have their age certificates properly attested.
- 10. Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match is concluded, provided that when necessary through circumstances not within the control of the players, the Umpire shall suspend play for such period as he may consider necessary. Play must never be suspended for the purpose of allowing a player to recover his strength or wind. The Umpire shall be the sole judge of intentional delay and, after giving due warning, may disqualify the offender. The Expedite Time Limit regulations will be enforced.
- 11. The Tournament is under the control of the Tournament Manager, Mr J.E. Butler and the Assistant Tournament Manager is Mr J.F. Fox. The Referee is Mr B.R. Thomson, holder of N.Z.T.T.A. Provincial Umpires Badge, and the Deputy Referee is Mr P.C. Berry.
- 12. JUNIOR PLAYERS PLEASE NOTE: In the interests of time, competitors are restricted to entering in six events only.

Morning and afternoon teas will be available in the Hall - There wi be no luncheon available this tournament - but a cup of tea will be available to those bringing their own lunch.
