SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1-Players not reporting by 9.30 a.m. will be scratched.
- 2-Entries without fees will be rejected.
- 3—Men's and Women's Singles events will be played on a knockout basis. There will be three plate events for men and women (depending on entries). Entry of each of these will be determined by which round of knockout draw a player is defeated. This will ensure each player at least three singles matches.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1—All matches will be played under the Rules of the N.Z. Table Tennis Association whose authority has been obtained to conduct this tournament.
- 2—Play will commence at 9.00 a.m. and continue until the tournament is complete. Light meals will be available at the Hall throughout the day. A tea break will be held.
- 3-Nittaku 3-Star balls will be used.
- 4—Twelve tables will be in use and each table will have a minimum run back of 5.0m; distance between tables is 2.8m; i.e. minimum playing area will be 12.8m by 4.3m.
- 5—All senior knockout matches will be the best of five advantage games of 21 points up; all junior and consolation events will be the best of three advantage games of 21 points up.
- 6-All Competitors must wear dark coloured clothing and white soled sandshoes while playing.
- 7-Competitors must report to the Tournament Secretary or Deputy on arrival at Hall.
- 8—Control of play will be by Call Board and the fact that a player's name has been placed on the Call Board shall be deemed to constitute adequate notice of an impending match. Failure of any player to answer such call within five minutes shall render that player liable to disqualification by the Tournament Manager. FIRST ROUND MATCHES WILL BE SHOWN ON BOARD at 8,45 a.m. Hall will be open at 8.15 a.m. for practice.
- 9—All contestants will find their own umpires before going up to the table. The first mentioned player on the call board shall secure the umpire.
- 10-The Committee will "seed" the draw.
- 11—Any player who wishes to enter for a doubles event but has no partner may do so and the Committee will endeavour to provide a partner.
- 12—Juniors under 16 years will be permitted to play in either both age groups or in one age group and the open events. Competitors are warned that in the event of a dispute regarding the eligibility for competing in age group events it may be necessary to demand verification of the date of birth.
- 13-Prize-giving will take place at the conclusion of the tournament
