CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. All matches will be played under the rules of the NZ Table Tennis Association (Inc)
- 2. The best quality 3-star Ball available will be used.
- 3. Players must wear dark clothing in all matches. Tennis shoes must be worn. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform with these requirements.
- 4. The Executive Committee will seed the draw.
- 5. All Open Single Championship events only shall be the best of five advantage games of 21 points up. All Junior events shall be the best of three advantage games of 21 up and played on Sunday commencing at 9.00 am.
- 6. The Expedite Rule will be enforced.
- 7. The Referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final. The decision of the Umpire on a point of fact is final.
- 8. All players must report to the Tournament Controller's table on arrival.
- 9. A Plate and Bracelet Event will be run

RIJLES FOR CONDUCTING SECTION PLAY IN MEN'S AND WOMEN'S OPEN SINGLES

- 1. Section play will be the best of 3 games.
- 2. Re section play, the number of sections and number of players in each section will be decided by the Nelson Association Tournament Committee.
- 3. Seeding for Section Play: Players will be separated in the sections according to their seeding.
- 4. Seeding for Knock-Out Play: It will be necessary for the Committee to re-seed players prior to making up the draw.
- 5. Players to Qualify: The Player with the greatest number of wins in a section will qualify. If two players are even, the winner of their own match will be the qualifier. Should more than two players be even, then they will all qualify. The Nelson Committee reserves the right to take forward more than one player from each section.
- 6. Knock-Out Contest: All qualifiers will contest the Knock-Out Championship Best of Five games.
- 7. Plate and Bracelet Events: All players who fail to qualify will be eligible for the Consolation events.

MANAGEMENT

One table will be allocated for each section if possible. The Committee to appoint one player from each section to manage that table and score sheet.

As soon as section play finishes on a table, the results must be returned to the Tourn. Manager without delay. The Manager reserves the right to play unfinished matches on any tables that become available.

JUNIORS may enter in maximum of TWO events only.
