CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. All matches will be played under the rules of the NZ Table Tennis Association.
- 2. Ball : Double Fish 3 Star Balls will be used.
- 3. Dress : Players must not wear white clothing in any match. Sandshoes of footwear approved by the Referee must be worn. Players not conforming to these rules will be scratched.
- 4. H B T T A Tournament Committee will make and seed the draw. It reserves the right to limit junior players participation to only 2 age groups.
- 5. EVENTS 1 & 2 WILL BE SECTIONALISED GUARANTEEING PLAYERS A MINIMUM OF 4 MATCHES. Play in all events will be the best of three advantage games of 21 points up except post section play of Events 1 & 2 which will be the best of five advantage games of 21 points. There will be plate events for non-qualifiers of these same events. Plate events also will be played for first match losers of under 15 and 19 singles events.
- 6. Entry into events 25 and 26 (2nd GRADE) is restricted to Hawkes Bay players not participating in A Grade interclub.
- 7. Hours of play : 9 30 am continuous to conclusion, or as advised at start of play. Junior and Senior Age events will be timetabled to be played at the conclusion of section play (approx 10.30 am)
- 8. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event for which less than four entries are received. Winners of events which have under 6 entries will be issued with certificates only.
- 9. Players entering Junior or Veteran age events are warned that in case of a dispute it will be necessary to provide verification of their date of birth. Note the date for determining age eligibility is 31 December 1992
- 10.All competitors must be affiliated members of the NZTTA or some other National Association affiliated to the ITTF.
- 11. ENTRIES MUST REACH THE TOURNAMENT SECRETARY, P 0 BOX 964, NAPIER BY MONDAY 28 JUNE 1992. ENTRIES NOT ACCOMPANIED BY FEES WILL BE SURCHARGED \$1.00 EXTRA. LATE ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED.
