7. Second Grade events are open to all Association players who play A reserve or below. Juniors under 19 are not eligible.

8. Dress: Players shall not wear white or light reflecting clothing or sweatbands. Tennis shoes must be worn. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform.

9. Only approved makes of bats and rubbers may be used.

10. Juniors may enter events only in their own age group, the age group above their own, Under 21 and Open.

11. Competitors must report to the officials in charge on arrival

at each session.

12. Players in singles events who are eliminated in their first played match will be eligible for such Consolation events as may be played. (To be determined by the Tournament Manager). 13. The O.T.T.A. reserves the right to cancel any event for which
