#### 1998 North Island Table Tennis Championships

#### CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. All matches will be played under the Rules of Table Tennis as adopted by TTNZ (Inc).
- 2. The Nittaku 3-star orange ball will be used.
- 3. TTNZ will nominate the seeded players and do the draw.
- 4. All events will be knockout draws. Subject to Condition 12, in all singles events players who lose their first round match will qualify for the Third Division singles and players who lose their second round match in the main draw or lose in the second full round of the main draw, shall be eligible for the Second Division singles. A copy of the full guidelines on eligibility for the Second and Third Divisions will be displayed on the notice board at the championships.
- 5. The main singles draws for the Open men's and women's singles will be the best of five advantage games. All other matches will be the best of three advantage games.
- 6. Juniors and veterans may enter a total of up to 9 events in the championships. (An event is an element <u>within</u> a category; e.g. the U13 boys singles is an event within the U13 age category.) Juniors and veterans may enter no more than two age categories which must be consecutive. The junior age categories are U19, U17, U15, U13 and the veteran age categories are O35, O40, O50, O60.
- 7. The date for determining eligibility for the U21, U19, U17, U15, U13 events is 31 December 1997. The date for the O35, O40, O50, O60 is 31 December, 1998. (This latter date is a change from the policy of previous years. Any player turning, for example, 40 any time during 1998 qualifies for Over 40 events throughout the 1998 season.) In the event of any dispute, verification of the date of birth will be required.
- 8. B and C Grade senior singles the eligibility of players to enter these events is determined by their position on TTNZ senior men's and women's Rating Lists.
  - (a) Players rated 25 and above are not eligible to play in B and C Grades.
  - (b) Men rated 100 and above and women rated 60 and above are not eligible for C Grade.
  - (c) Players who do not have a senior rating may enter C Grade.
  - (d) Players cannot enter more than two of the senior singles events.
    - (e) Players in doubt as to their eligibility to enter B and C Grades are recommended to enter and if not eligible their entry will be placed in the next highest grade or where appropriate their entry fee will be refunded. If there is any doubt, include a note of your intent with the entry form.
- 9. Matches commence each day at the times indicated unless advised otherwise by the Tournament Manager. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to default any player who arrives late.
- 10. Any player requiring dispensation from the rules regarding the wearing of tracksuits because of a disability or some other valid reason, should obtain permission from the Referee before play commences.
- 11. Only bats with approved rubbers and approved racket covering adhesive may be used. Umpires are required to examine all bats of each player prior to the commencement of each match. A list of approved adhesives can be obtained from your local association.
- 12. Events with less than 6 entries for singles, and 4 for doubles may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ or the organising committee.
- 13. Entries postmarked after the closing date and entries without fees will be rejected. Any competitor who fails to forward the correct fees shall be liable to a surcharge of double the amount short-paid in addition to the amount outstanding.
- 14. Holders of permanent trophies are reminded that the trophies must be returned to the Host Association, at least one month before the date of the championships. They are also advised that they are liable to a fine of \$20 for each trophy returned without appropriate engraving.
- 15. No applications for refunds will be considered for withdrawals made after Friday, 19 June. Any applications are to be made to TTNZ. Refunds where doubles partners are not allocated will be made by the host association.
- 16. If acknowledgement of receipt of entry is required, please enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
- 17. The NZ Sports Drug Agency may do random testing.
- 18. This tournament is open only to TTNZ Registered Players. Registration numbers must be shown in the designated space on the name and address panel at the top of the entry form. (PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS THE FIRST TOURNAMENT FOR WHICH THIS CONDITION APPLIES. REGISTRATION FORMS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM YOUR CLUB OR ASSOCIATION)
