#### 1999 NEW ZEALAND CHAMPIONSHIPS

#### **Conditions of Play**

- Only members of TTNZ may enter. Membership numbers <u>must</u> be quoted on entry forms.
- 2 All matches will be played under the Rules of Table Tennis as adopted by TTNZ.
- 3 The Nittaku 3-star orange ball will be used.
- 4. TTNZ will nominate the seeded players and do the draw.
- 5. All events will be knockout draws. Consolation singles events will be played.
- 6. The main singles draws for the open men's and women's singles will be the best of five advantage games. All other events will be the best of three advantage games.
- 7. Juniors and veterans may enter no more than two age categories which must be consecutive. The junior age categories are U19, U17, U15, U13 and the veteran age categories are O35, O45, O55.
- The date for determining eligibility for the U21, U19, U17, U15, U13 events is 31 December 1998. The date for the O35, O45, O55 is 31 December, 1999. In the event of any dispute, verification of the date of birth will be required.
- 9. B and C Grade senior singles The eligibility of players to enter these events is determined by their position on the TTNZ senior men's and women's Rating Lists.
  - (a) Players rated 25 and above are not eligible to play in B and C Grades.
  - (b) Men rated 100 and above and women rated 60 and above are not eligible for C Grade.
  - (c) Players who do not have a senior rating may enter C Grade.
  - (d) Players cannot enter more than two of the senior singles events.
  - (e) Players in doubt as to their eligibility to enter B and C Grades are recommended to enter and if not eligible their entry will be placed in the next highest grade or where appropriate their entry fee will be refunded.

The last list published prior to closure of entries will be used to determine eligibility. In the case of any player formerly on the list who has dropped off due to 12 months inactivity, eligibility will be determined by their points on the most recent list they appeared on. TTNZ may apply discretion with players inactive for long periods.

- 10. The right is reserved to make alterations to any draw.
- 11. Matches commence each day at the times indicated unless advised otherwise by the Tournament Manager. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to default any player who arrives late.
- 12. Any player requiring dispensation from the rules regarding the wearing of tracksuits because of disability or some other valid reason, should obtain permission from the Referee before play commences.
- 13. Only bats with approved rubbers and approved racket covering adhesive may be used. Umpires are required to examine all bats of each player prior to the commencement of each match. A list of approved adhesives can be obtained from your local association.
- 14. Events with less than 6 entries for singles, and 4 for doubles may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ.
- 15. Entries postmarked after the closing date and entries without fees will be rejected. Any competitor who fails to forward the correct fees shall be liable to a surcharge of double the amount short-paid in addition to the amount outstanding.
- 16. Holders of permanent trophies are reminded that the trophies must be returned to the host association, at least one month before the date of the championships. They are also advised that they are liable to a fine of \$20 for each trophy returned without appropriate engraving.
- 17. No applications for refunds will be considered for withdrawals made after 6 September, 1999. Any applications are to be made to TTNZ. Refunds where doubles partners are not allocated will be made by the host association.
- 18. Random drug testing could be carried out during the championships. Competitors, especially those under medication, should obtain medical advice.
- 19. If acknowledgement of receipt of entry is required, please enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
