Conditions of Play

- [1] The tournament will be played under TTNZ rules.
- [2] Orange Nittaku 3-star balls will be used.
- (3) Consolation or plate events will be held if time permits.
- [4] The WTTA reserves the right to combine or cancel events.
- [5] The Wellington Code of Conduct will apply.
- [6] December 31, 1998 is the criterion date for eligibility for U13, U15, U17, U19 & U21 events. The criterion date for the Over 40, Over 50 & Over 60 events shall be 31 December 1999. (i.e. a player turning 40 any time in 1999 is eligible for Over 40 events.)
- [7] Senior players are limited to: a) two age groups only, or
 b) two age groups as well as the Open or 2nd Division
 No player may enter both the Open and 2nd Division events.
- [8] Sunday: juniors are restricted to 2 consecutive age groups.
- [9] Dress: do not wear clothing of a similar hue and intensity to those of the orange Nittaku 3-star balls. White clothing is OK.
- [10] Competitors must be available when their match is scheduled. The upper player on the board shall arrange the umpire.
- [11] The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary conditions of play.
- [12] Please enter "Partner Required" if you need a doubles partner, otherwise enter your partner's name and ensure they enter too!
- [13] Games to be best of 3 advantage up to 21, except for Open Singles events which are best of 5 advantage up to 21.
- [14] Division 2 events open to players below Wellington/Hutt Valley Premier 2 interclub standard. Eligibility of players from outside the Wellington/Hutt Valley associations will be determined by the tournament committee.
- [15] All competitors must be registered under the Table Tennis New Zealand Individual Membership Registration (IMR).
