TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

EQUIPMENT & PLAYING CONDITIONS

- Tables: Butterfly Europa, Blue
- Nets: Butterfly, Blue or Black
- Balls: Butterfly 3 star, Orange

ELIGIBILITY

- Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible. TTNZ members must quote their membership number on their entry form.
- Eligibility for age-group events is determined by age as at 31.12.03 for Under 13 – Under 21, and as at 31.12.04 for Over 35 – Over 70. Proof of age may be required.
- Eligibility for B grade: players below 25 on last rating list published prior to the close of entries
- Eligibility for C grade: men below 100, women below 60 on the same rating list
- TTNZ reserves the right to accept or reject entries in B & C grade from players who do not appear on the rating list

ENTRIES

- Must be postmarked no later than closing date and arrive at TTNZ no later than 7 days after closing date.
- Must be accompanied by the correct fees.
- In addition to Open, Graded, Over 35 and Under 21 events, no player may enter more than two age categories which must be consecutive (i.e. Under 15 and Under 17; or Over 45 and Over 55; etc).
- TTNZ reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion.
- Players may enter events in the Open, B & C grade categories without restriction.
- Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.

DRAWS & MATCHES

- For singles events section play shall be conducted on a round robin basis, followed by post-section knock-out play to which some players may be granted direct entry. (Full guidelines are in the updated TTNZ Handbook recently distributed to all associations). Round Robins will be groups of 4 with only one player to qualify for the main draw.
- There will be no consolation events.
- For doubles events, seeded knockout draws shall be conducted except where less than 6 pairs have entered. The round-robin format may then be used.
- Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ. Players so affected will be entered in the next lower age category if they are not already in that category (providing they are eligible).
- The right is reserved to make alterations to any draw.
- All open singles post-section matches shall be best of seven advantage games to 11; all other matches shall be best of five advantage games to 11.

DRUGS

- The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing.

GLUEING

- No Glueing shall be permitted inside the stadium other than within areas designated for the purpose.

AUTHORITY

- The Tournament Management reserves the right to vary these conditions, with the agreement of the TTNZ Liaison Officer, and to exercise control over all activities within the stadium and adjacent areas. This includes the right to default players who fail to respond when called to the table within the published or announced playing session times.
- The Referee and delegated Assistant Referee reserve the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. Their interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.

CLOTHING

- Approved Table Tennis clothing must be worn – refer TTNZ website

RACKET COVERING

- Approved racket coverings must be used as per latest ITTF list – see ITTF website
