ELIGIBILITY

Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible. TTNZ members must
quote their membership number on their entry form.

• Eligibility for age-group events is determined by age as at 31.12.05 for Under 21 - Under 13 and as at 31.12.06 for Over

40 - Over 70. Proof of age may be required.

Eligibility for B grade: players below 25 on last rating list published prior to the close of entries.

Eligibility for C grade: men below 100, women below 60 on the same rating list.

• TTNZ reserves the right to accept or reject entries in B & C grade from players who do not appear on the rating list.

ENTRIES

• Envelopes containing entries must be postmarked no later than the closing date and arrive at TTNZ no later than 7 days after the closing date.

Entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. TTNZ reserves the right to impose a penalty for late payments. Fees

are refundable if advice of a withdrawal is received by TTNZ within 14 days of the closing date.

• In addition to open, graded, and Under 21 events, no player may enter more than two age categories which must be consecutive (ie, Under 15 and Under 17, or Over 40 and Over 50, etc).

No player may enter all three of the Open, B & C grade categories but may enter any consecutive two (ie Open and B, or B and C, but not Open and C).

TTNZ reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion.

Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.

 Any entrant wishing to receive acknowledgment of receipt of their entry form must enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope. Otherwise entries will be processed without acknowledgment.

 Players enter at their own risk and no responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during the tournament.

DRAWS

• For singles events section play shall be conducted on a round robin basis, followed by post-section knock-out play to which some players may be granted direct entry. (Full guidelines are in the updated TTNZ Handbook recently distributed to all associations). Round robins will be groups of 4 with 2 players to qualify for the main draw and 2 for the consolation event. Consolation events will be held for all singles events.

For doubles events seeded knock-out draws shall be conducted except where less than 6 pairs have entered. The

round-robin format may then be used.

Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ. Players so
affected will be entered in the next lower age category if they are not already in that category.

The right is reserved to make alterations to any draw.

MATCHES

All post-section men's and women's open singles matches shall be best of seven advantage games to 11. All other
matches shall be best of five advantage games to 11.

DRUGS

The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing.

GLUEING

No glueing shall be permitted inside the stadium other than within areas designated for the purpose.

AUTHORITY

 The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary these conditions, with the agreement of the TTNZ Liaison Officer, and to exercise control over all activities within the stadium and adjacent areas. This includes the right to default players who fail to respond when called to the table within the published or announced playing session times.

The Referee and delegated assistants reserve the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. Their interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.
