 For singles events, section play shall be conducted on a round robin basis, followed by post-section knock-out play to which some pl granted direct entry. Round robins will be groups of 4 where possible with 2 players to qualify for the main draw. For doubles events, seeded knock-out draws shall be conducted except where less than 6 pairs have entered, the round robin forma used. Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ. Players so affected will be the next appropriate grade or age group.
