*We asked 1999 TTNZ Hall of Fame inductee, **Alan Tomlinson**, who turns 84 as the tournament commences, what he could recall of the inaugural 1987 NZ Veterans Championships..*

The 1987 tournament was staged in July in Auckland, immediately after the North Island Championships. But, my considerable enthusiasm for The Chase, Tipping Point, the last bit of Jeopardy and any quiz in print has not left me with perfect recall of my matches from over 30 years ago.

In 1987, I did win the Over 40 and Over 50 singles. Whom I beat is an old memory, but I may have beaten Warren Evans in the 40s final and a left-handed South Australian hard bat chopper, Eugene Herman, who recently passed away, in the 50s. He paired with Bryan Foster to reach the 1968 Australian final.

Since 1987 the National Vets Champs have always been held at Easter. We ventured to Christchurch in 1988 to stay with the Williams family, including 6 month old Guy. His Dad, and current TTNZ Chairman, Gary was learning the ropes with McDonalds. I won five events, but lost the 40 final to Warren Evans, after leading 18-14 in the third.

My only other attempt at winning Vets titles was in Auckland in 1996. In that year, we were allowed to play in three age groups. I bombed in all three singles, but Eugene Herman and I won the Over 40 and Over 50 doubles.

I am playing about 3 times a fortnight currently, and enjoying it a lot more than I often have in recent times. I feel it is very good for my health. I played in the 2014 World Veterans Championships and last competed in the World masters in 2016.but have no plans to play in Taupo. But I hope it all goes well for those attending.

## Pamela Tait (Australia) ---- A Personal Profile

The wonderful and fulfilling sport of table tennis has been part of my life for more than 50 years as a player, administrator and selector. As a player I have represented Victoria and Australia. As an administrator I have served on the Victoria Table Tennis Board, the Victoria Veterans Committee since its inception and organising committees of the Australian Open and 2002 World Masters (Table Tennis). I have been a Junior Selector for Australia and a Junior and Veteran Selector for Victoria. Observing and contributing to the growth and success of all areas of table tennis has given me enormous enjoyment and satisfaction.

I was privileged to be the winner of the Over 40 Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles at the inaugural NZ Veteran Championships in 1997. It seems like it were just yesterday. I am lucky enough to keep fit and healthy and am the only current player to have played in all 34 Australian Veteran Championships since 1984.

It was an honour to be a volunteer at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne. Attending the opening ceremony at the MCG with the Queen in attendance was an inspiration and unforgettable experience. Other administrative highlights include a fund-raising tournament for the Cancer Foundation and participating in University research dealing with the challenge of attracting teenage girls to table tennis.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**Equipment:** Stag Americas & Stag Karlsson Tables, Stag Nets, Stag 3 Star White Plastic Balls

### Eligibility:

- ▶ Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible.
- ▶ Eligibility for age group events is determined by age as at 31st December of Year of Play for Over 40/50/60/65/70/75/80 events.
- ▶ TTNZ reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion, and may require proof of birth date.

### Entries & Draws:

- ▶ Entries must be accompanied by correct fees. TTNZ reserves the right to reject entries not accompanied by the correct fees. Fees are refundable if advice of a withdrawal is received by TTNZ no later than 14 days after the closing date.
- ▶ If part or all of the event is cancelled, refund is limited to value of applicable entry fees paid. No additional compensation is payable.
- ▶ No player may enter more than two age categories, which must be consecutive i.e. Over 40 and Over 50.
- ▶ For singles events, section play shall be conducted on a round robin basis, followed by post-section knock-out play to which some players may be granted direct entry. Round robins will be groups of 4 where possible, with 2 players to qualify for the main draw and 2 for the consolation event. Consolation events will be held in singles events if time permits.
- ▶ For doubles, seeded knock-out draws shall be conducted for 6 or more pairs, and round robins may be used for less.
- ▶ Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.
- ▶ Doubles pairings shall wear the same colour shirts, unless entered as partner required.
- ▶ Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ. Players so affected will be entered in the next appropriate grade or age group.
- ▶ All matches shall be best of five advantage games to 11.
- ▶ All players must be present to play or umpire the first match of a pool, and must be present on time for any scheduled knockout match
- ▶ All emailed entries will be acknowledged via return email.
- ▶ Players enter at their own risk and no responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during the tournament.

### Teams Conditions:

- ▶ Associations may enter one or more teams in each age group.
- ▶ Associations which have only one player available for any championship may apply to have that player placed in the draft pool.
- ▶ TTNZ will allocate drafting pool players to teams and their decision is final.
- ▶ All draft teams are named "Presidents". Members will wear navy shirts and black shorts or skirts, and are eligible to win events.
- ▶ Players to supply their own uniforms and be responsible for the fee.
- ▶ Draft pool team entry is \$40 per player per team.
- ▶ Teams shall comprise of two players but a third or fourth player may play in the doubles or after a result is obtained.
- ▶ A maximum of four different players may play for any one team throughout the championships.
- ▶ Players are invited to watch XY/AB pre-toss by referee, and encouraged to notify playing order, at least 30 minutes before play.
- ▶ The format of each teams championship shall be confirmed by the Referee once the number of entries is known.
- ▶ It will, generally be on a round robin basis and more than one grade may be played for each age group.

### Other Conditions:

- ▶ The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing.
- ▶ No glueing shall be permitted inside the stadium.
- ▶ The Tournament Manager is authorised to make any such decisions on any issues relating to the tournament that are not covered by the TTNZ handbook regulations (for National Veteran Championships) or entry form conditions.
- ▶ The Tournament Referee reserves the right to apply and enforce the Laws of Table Tennis as adopted by TTNZ.
- ▶ A Jury Panel will be appointed prior to tournament commencement, with names posted on a notice board .
- ▶ Appeals against any decision by the Referee must be lodged within one hour on TTNZ completed complaint form with the Jury Panel or TTNZ Liaison Officer.
- ▶ Gold and Silver Medals shall be presented to finalists for all events and Bronze medals to losing semi-finalists where the draw exceeds 16 singles players or 8 doubles pairings.
- ▶ Approved racket coverings must be used as per the ITTF list current at the date of the tournament.

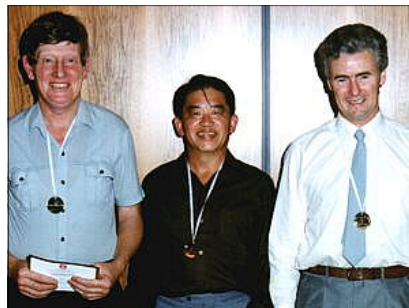

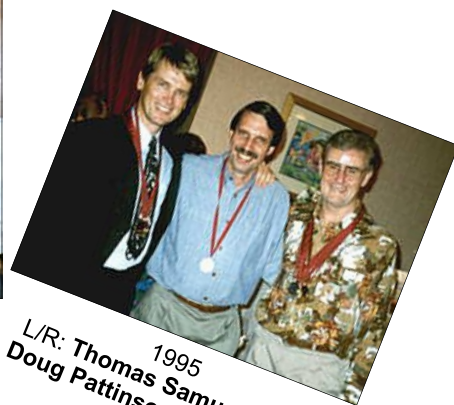

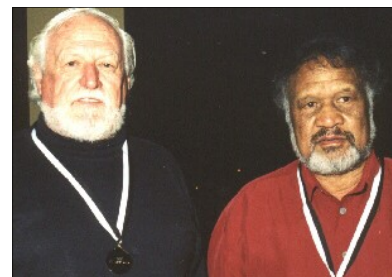
